

What can teams expect as they enter WCA on game day?

- All athletes and coaches must wear face coverings when entering the building and gymnasium.
- All athletes can enter the building once their coach/es have arrived at the school; otherwise, kindly wait in your car until coach arrival.
- All athletes will have their temperature taken upon entering the school's front entrance.
- Upon entering the school, please proceed forward to the gymnasium doors to your right. Side hallways will be locked and are off-limits. Access to the front hallway bathrooms is permitted.
- Team members should arrive dressed-out for games. There is no use of the back hall locker rooms for changing purposes. Locker rooms will only be utilized for team huddles during breaks in a contest.
- There will be hand sanitizer stations at each entrance of the gymnasium and placed beside each team bench. Please utilize upon entering and exiting the gymnasium and as necessary during gameplay.
- The Home team will provide warm-up balls for the visiting team. No personal game balls are permitted at this time.
- Teams will not switch benches nor sides of the court during games.
- Teams will use sanitized game balls between each scheduled game, and as needed, game balls will be rotated out of play and sanitized accordingly.
- No community water jugs will be permitted. Each athlete should bring individual water bottles to games.

What can spectators expect as they enter WCA on game day?

- All spectators must wear face coverings when entering the building and gymnasium.
- Spectators will have their temperature taken upon entering the school's front entrance.
- Upon entering the school, please proceed forward to the gymnasium doors to your right. Side hallways will be locked and are strictly off-limits. Access to front hallway bathrooms is permitted.
- The Virginia Metro Athletic Conference is adhering to a strict spectator policy due to Covid-19 regulations. Each athlete may have a max of 2 spectators present at games, which include siblings.
- Admissions will continue as usual with Adult spectators \$4 and non-WCA students \$2; WCA students and children under 5 are free.
- Each athlete will have an allowance of 2 spectators. A roster of athletes will be kept at the admissions table, and allowed spectators will be checked at the door.
- Volunteers will NOT be counted under the two spectators per athlete max; Volunteers receive free admission into games.
- Areas on bleachers for viewing games will be designated by circular blue WCA stickers indicating 10 foot spacing between parties.
- Spectators and Volunteers are expected to adhere (to the best of their abilities) to the face-covering requirement, both when moving about or when seated.
- At the conclusion of games, all spectators must exit the gymnasium and building swiftly through the right side doors and wait for your athlete(s) outdoors. No socializing on the court or inside the building is permitted during this time.
- If you have an athlete in a consecutive game, we ask that you stay seated until all other spectators have exited the building.
- Concessions items, including individually wrapped snacks and plastic beverage bottles, will be sold throughout the contests. Volunteers shall wear face coverings and gloves at all times.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding of these regulations as we strive to provide a healthy and safe environment for your athletes and families during this transitional time.
